

ROMANIZATION SYSTEM FOR MACEDONIAN CYRILLIC

BGN/PCGN 2013 Agreement

Macedonian was officially established as a literary language in Yugoslavia during World War II and is now the official language of Macedonia. This romanization system replaces the BGN/PCGN 1981 agreement and adheres to the most widely-accepted standardization of Macedonian orthography.
