

# ROMANIZATION OF BELARUSIAN

BGN/PCGN 1979 System

The BGN/PCGN system for Belarusian (formerly referred to as Byelorussian) was designed for use in romanizing names written in the Belarusian Cyrillic alphabet. The Belarusian alphabet contains three characters not present in the Russian alphabet: i, ŷ, and '.

## NOTES

1. The Romanization column shows only lowercase forms but, when romanizing, uppercase and lowercase Roman letters as appropriate should be used.
2. The character sequences зг, кг, сг, тс and цр and may be romanized **z·h**, **k·h**, **s·h**, **t·s** and **ts·h** in order to differentiate those romanizations from the digraphs **zh**, **kh**, **sh**, **ts**, and the letter sequence **tsh**, which are used to render the characters ж, х, ш, ц, and the character sequence тш.
3. All apostrophes appearing in romanization are Unicode encoding 2019.
4. The Romanization columns show only lowercase forms but, when romanizing, uppercase and lowercase Roman letters as appropriate should be used.
